- 4. Represents restricted stock units awarded as part of the Company's Long Term Incentive Plan. Twenty-five percent (25%) of total units awarded vest and are payable, solely in shares of common stock of the Company, on each anniversary of the April 27, 2007 award date.
- 5. Represents Performance Units which will be awarded to the Reporting Person under the Company's Equity Incentive Plan upon achievement of the targeted total shareholder return for each of three (3) consecutive callendar years. The maximum number of Performance Units which may be earned is two hundred percent (200%) of the Performance Units awarded for target level performance and the minimum number of Performance Units which may be earned is zero (0) Performance Units.
