- 2. Represents restricted stock units awarded as part of the Company's Long Term Incentive Plan. Twenty-five percent (25%) of the total units awarded vest and are payable, solely in shares of common stock of the Company, on January 3, 2013 and on each January 3rd thereafter through January 3, 2016.
- 3. Represents restricted stock units awarded as part of the Company's Long Term Incentive Plan. Twenty-five percent (25%) of the total units awarded vest and are payable, solely in shares of common stock of the Company, on each anniversary of the January 4, 2010 award date.
- 4. Represents restricted stock units awarded as part of the Company's Long Term Incentive Plan. Twenty-five percent (25%) of the total units awarded vest and are payable, solely in shares of common stock of the Company, on each anniversary of the January 5, 2009 award date.
- 5. Represents restricted stock units awarded as a supplemental retirement benefit that vest and are payable solely in shares of common stock of the Company on the day following the retirement of the Reporting Person; provided that such retirement occurs after the latest to occur of (i) the date the Recipient attains age sixty (60); (ii) the end of the five (5) year period beginning on the date the Reporting Person is hired by the Company; or (iii) the end of the one (1) year period beginning on the date of this award. Restricted stock units also vest and are payable in shares of common stock of the Company upon the death or disability of the Reporting Person or if the Reporting Person's employment with the Company is terminated without cause. - 12. Represents restricted stock units allocated pursuant to the Company's Management Stock Purchase Plan funded by the deferral of receipt by Reporting Person of a portion of his annual incentive compensation award.
- 13. Represents an option to purchase shares of common stock of the Company awarded to the Reporting Person pursuant to the Company's 2005 Equity Incentive Plan.
- 14. Represents Performance Units which will be awarded to the Reporting Person under the Company's Equity Stock Incentive Plan upon achievement of the targeted total shareholder return for a designated performance period. The maximum number of Performance Units which may be earned is two hundred percent (200%) of the Performance Units awarded for target level performance and the minimum number of Performance Units which may be earned is zero (0) Performance Units.
- 15. Performance Units vest and are paid at the end of the three (3) consecutive calendar year period ending December 31, 2014 or, if earlier, upon death, disability or retirement. Performance Units are forfeited if employment is terminated before December 31, 2014 for reasons other than death, disability or retirement or by the Company without cause. Performance Units are payable solely in cash in an amount equal to the ninety (90) day trailing average price of one (1) share of the Company's common stock determined as of December 31, 2014 or, if applicable, death, disability or retirement.
