Represents the number of restricted stock units remaining with respect to January 3, 2006 grant of 2,228 restricted stock units after the conversion to common stock of 557 restricted stock units resulting from the vesting of twenty-five percent (25%) of such restricted stock units on each anniversary of the grant date.
