Represents a decrease of the targeted number of Performance Units awarded to the Reporting Person on April 3, 2017 under the Company's 2015 Equity Incentive Plan as a result of the Company's achievement of a return on invested capital below the targeted return on invested capital for 2017. The Compensation Committee has reviewed and confirmed the Company's calculation of Return on Invested Capital for 2017 as compared to target and approved the resulting decrease in the number of Performance Units.
- 3. Twenty-five percent (25%) of the total number of options granted vest and become exercisable on each anniversary grant date.
